This qualification focuses on the delegates ability to enter and work in confined spaces which have been risk assessed and designated NC1 within the Water UK Scheme by demonstrating the ability to:

- Verify isolation from risk
- Establish a safety zone at the access and egress point
- Establish and maintain an appropriate communication system
- Set out and interpret atmosphere monitors
- Maintain safe working procedures for work being done
- Follow emergency procedure

This qualification has been designed by City & Guilds to meet the requirements of Water UK and are water industry specific.
