What Will Be Covered?

This qualification covers use of escape breathing apparatus and self-contained breathing apparatus as part of the planned means of self-rescue at NC2, NC3 and NC4 confined space entries.

This Qualification Covers:

- Carrying out pre-use checks
- Using self contained breathing apparatus
- Carrying out post-use hygiene routines

This qualification focuses on the delegates ability to:

- Select equipment
- Check operational condition
- Don and use compressed air breathing apparatus
- Effect an emergency evacuation of a confined space wearing breathing apparatus as a part of the planned means of self rescue
- Check and carry out user maintenance
- Follow safe working procedures

This qualification has been designed by City & Guilds to meet the requirements of Water UK and are water industry specific.

Course Includes:

- City and Guilds certificate which is valid for three years (on completion of course)

Course Requirements

All candidates wishing to take a City and Guilds confined space qualification should be a minimum of 16 years old and be medically fit.
