

## City & Guilds 6160-04 Control Entry and Arrangements for (High Risk) Confined Spaces

This course is for the entry controller/top person who controls entry and arrangements for confined spaces without entering them. It includes the duties of an entry controller, pre-entry procedures, entry into and exit from the confined space, maintaining communications and initiating and controlling emergency procedures.

### Who will it benefit?

Any person who is appointed by their employer to control entry into (high risk) confined spaces

### *This course will cover:*

- ◆ Legislation relevant to confined spaces safety.
- ◆ Hazards and their controls.
- ◆ Safe systems of work.
- ◆ Personal protection
- ◆ Gas detection.
- ◆ Escape and Working Duration Breathing Apparatus
- ◆ Access equipment.
- ◆ Implementing procedures for entry teams, control safe entry and exit, monitor the entry team, control emergency situations.

### Core assessment:

- ◆ Practical exercises: Preparation for entry, monitoring of working, exiting and dealing with emergencies within confined spaces.

### Additional Information

Delegates should bring their own PPE e.g. Safety Boots, overalls, helmet, gloves, Knee pads

### Health Standard

Fit to control High Risk “Confined Spaces”, able to manage Breathing Apparatus and ancillary equipment used in support of high risk confined space entries.
